2021 IMPACT REPORT

Looking Back on an Impactful Year

Over the past year Daily Bread experienced significant growth both in staff and services. Our growth was driven by the need to provide unsheltered people more than the resources necessary to help them tackle the challenges of homelessness, but overcome their homelessness situation and find stable housing. The pathway from street to home is different for each person. When we get to know someone who is homeless, our team works together to strategize with them to find an acceptable and meaningful pathway home. Last year, Daily Bread assisted **147** people relocate to a housing opportunity. Of those 147 individuals, **seven** needed support finding housing at a regular market rate, **83** were reunited with friends and/or family and **57** individuals required comprehensive support to find their pathway home from our stellar housing success team.

Looking Ahead to Further Impact

In 2022, we are looking ahead toward new initiatives to continue to increase our impact in addressing homelessness in our community. Approximately 12 years ago leadership made plans to move and expand Daily Bread operations. Unfortunately those plans did not come to fruition. New opportunities to move and expand have recently resurfaced and we are working diligently and judiciously with city and community partners to uncover the possibilities. Stay tuned to learn more about what is to come.

PATHWAYS HOME SUCCESS STORY

Jerry O. took care of his mother seven years prior to her passing. The grief Jerry experienced over the loss of his mother sent him into severe depression. He turned to alcohol for consolation. In May 2019, those and other challenges tossed him into homelessness. Community members found him and brought him to Daily Bread. For two years, Jerry came to Daily Bread for showers, clean clothes and intensive housing services. In January 2021, Jerry was successful in finding housing with the assistance of Daily Bread. "I have no words to describe how much Daily Bread has helped me."

This year, Jerry will be signing a **SECOND YEAR LEASE!** Our staff couldn't be more proud of him!





PATHWAYS HOME is a program dedicated to helping persons experiencing homelessness in our community find their way home. One person's pathway might be a Greyhound bus ticket to **reunify** with a family member or friend in another state who can provide a safe and comfortable place to stay. For others, a pathway home may come in the form of assistance towards finding an affordable housing or **market rate** option. Other individuals may require intensive **Case Management Housing Services** which includes acquiring identification documentation, verifying benefits and qualification for government assistance.


